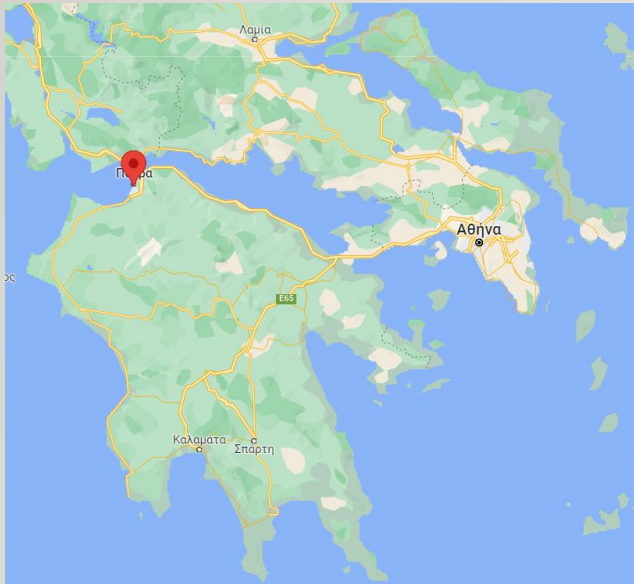

ORGANIZING YOUR TRAVEL



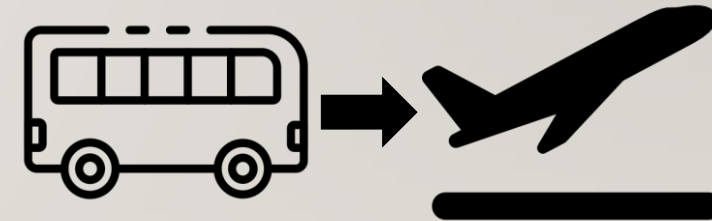
For your way from Athens International Airport to Patras we will arrange a shuttle bus to pick you up and transfer you to the venue.

Please book your departure flights in order to **depart from Athens International Airport after 12.00 on 11th October 2022** so as to catch the shuttle bus.

4 participants – youth workers (18+) experienced in youth projects and interested in the topic will participate from the coordinator.

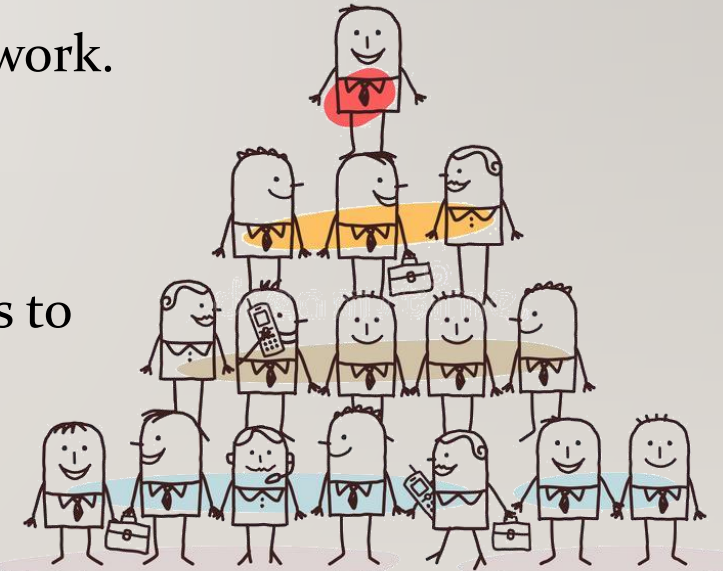


PARTICIPANTS

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



Accommodation, food (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and program materials will be totally covered by project's budget.

Transportation costs of all participants will be covered by project's budget up to Erasmus+ limits of transportation costs for a certain country, based on Erasmus+ distance calculator.

Buying all tickets is an obligation of participants (with partners' organization support).

PLEASE DO NOT buy your tickets without having prior confirmation from the coordinator.

Note that the following costs will NOT be covered by the project's budget: **Taxi, Personal Car, Parking, Extra luggage, Personal Costs.**

REIMBURSEMENT RULES



Before booking a ticket, please ask the coordinator for approving the ticket.

After approval of the tickets, you can book the tickets.

Forward all e-tickets and boarding passes to the project's coordinator e-mail.
Also, bring all original tickets and boarding passes printed during the Youth Exchange.

If tickets are booked in another currency, the amount will be converted to euros (€) according to the currency rate of the day that the tickets were booked according to European Central Bank.

Missing or lost tickets are not reimbursed. Tickets with longer extra stay will NOT be reimbursed.

NOTE: The reimbursement will be done by bank transfer, for all participants in the NGOs' accounts when all documents are fulfilled.

SAFETY AND HEALTH ISSUES



Health Insurance

Participants are themselves responsible to get a travel insurance. We do encourage to issue at least European Health Insurance Card or an Additional Travel Insurance. If anyone who uses medicine should bring with themselves. We don't give any medicines and we don't cover insurance fees.

Allergies – Food Preferences – Special Diet

If there's any person with special diet/allergies, please inform us via the application form mentioned previously in the Infopack. It is especially important for us to know about diets/allergies/special needs.
