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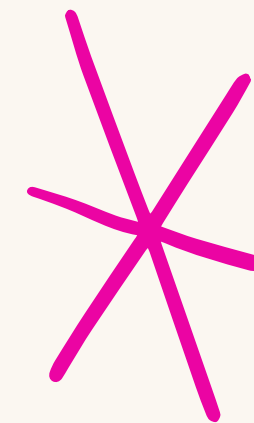
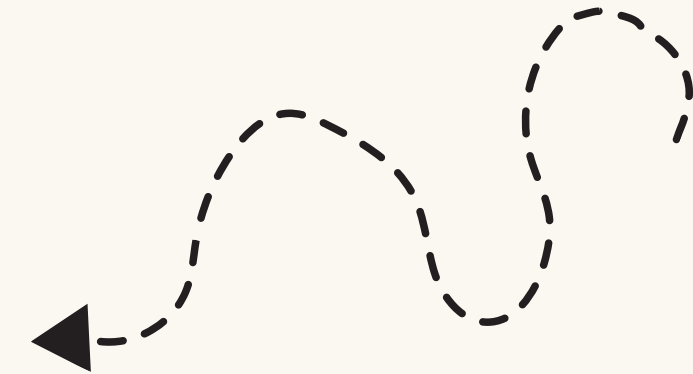
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

a project of mobility of youth workers





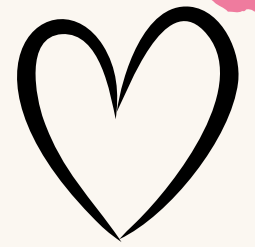
INTRODUCTION

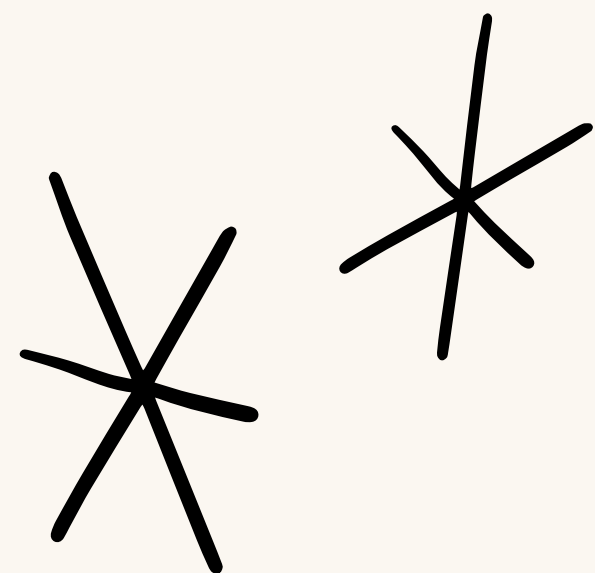

- to give participants an opportunity to share methods they use in youth work with the others
- to develop organisational and digital skills of youth workers, teachers and volunteers
- to increase awareness of participants about nonformal education and its methods
- to improve creative competences of the participants
- to improve IT competences of the participants in communication with other participants of the project, in creating promotion of the project and in organisation of dissemination activities
- to strengthen international cooperation
- to give participants an opportunity to learn more about other cultures



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PARTICIPANTS' PROFILES

THE PROJECT IS INTENDED FOR

youth workers - teachers - volunteers in NGOs

You should have experience with daily work with young people and with using IT tools in youth work. You should be directly connected with the work of the NGO or school that is the sending organization. **We keep the right to refuse participation of applicants who do not match criteria and intentions of the project.**



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Ice-breakers

- to know each other better and to learn about the work of other participants in their NGOs or schools.

Dissemination

- Dissemination activities to promote the project and follow-up activities to practice gained skills in the work with youth in the partner organizations.

Presentations

- Presentations of good example practices in the participating organizations and schools with using IT tools in their daily work with youth.

Evaluation

- Self-evaluation of the progress of participants to recognize the benefit of the project and evaluation activities to give feedback to other participants and the organizers of the project.

Workshops

- learning new IT tools that can be used in the partner organizations to attract new youngsters for various activities, for promotion of the work of the NGOs or schools, practising the tools and apps to develop digital skills.

Cultural evenings

- Intercultural evenings to present the partner countries, their culture, ways of life, education, history, traditions and food.

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TRAVEL AND FINANCES

The project is financially supported by the Erasmus+ programme.

- Travel costs will be reimbursed by hosting organization up to the maximum limit given by the Erasmus+ rules according to the Erasmus+ distance calculator based on your travel tickets and real costs. Travel tickets must be approved by us before you buy them!

Accommodation, meals, programme etc. will be covered by the organizers. Anyway, you can help us cover project costs which cannot be paid from the budget by **voluntary contribution** of 20 Euros which will be used within this project. If you decide to contribute, you can do it via bank transfer so that your contribution was transparent.



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Your **real travel costs** will be reimbursed upon your travel tickets. The maximum travel budget depends on the travel distance shown on the **official Distance calculator** by the European Commission:

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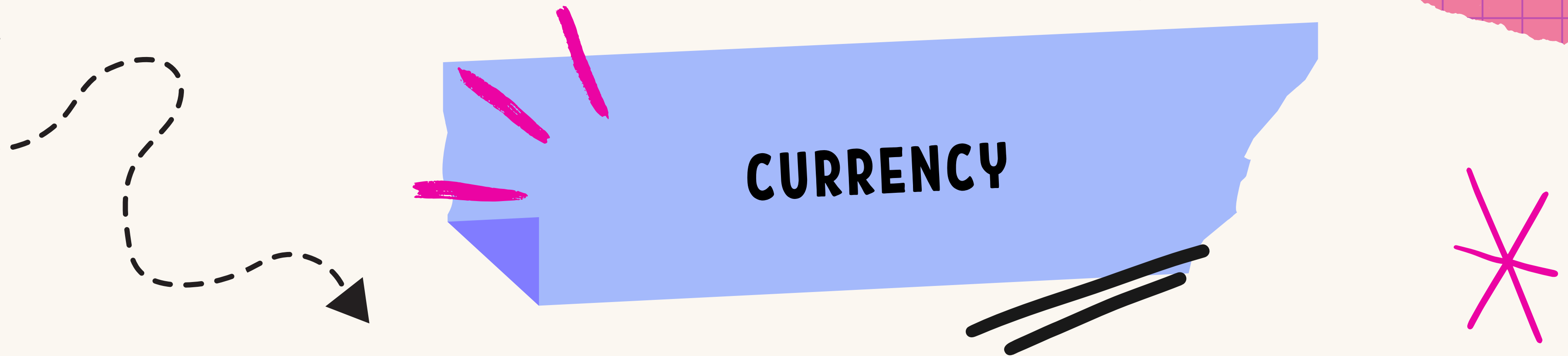
REIMBURSEMENT

Reimbursement of your **real travel costs** will be made **to your sending organization via bank transfer**. The payment will be done after collecting all your travel tickets and invoices, check and calculations by the accountant and once the compulsory Participants report is submitted, dissemination activities by your team are finished and dissemination report sent to the organizers. (We suppose this would take about 1-2 months till everything is completed).

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The currency in the Czech Republic is Czech crown (100 CZK is about 4,2 EUR). Please bring Czech crowns to the venue as it is not possible to exchange your currency to Czech crowns at the venue and there is no ATM nearby (we will be in the mountains). You can change your money either in your country before your journey or in Prague or Ostrava when you arrive.

All costs regarding the training (accommodation, food) will be covered as usual in Erasmus+ projects. You will need to cover your personal expenses and travel insurance.



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THINGS TO BRING WITH YOU

Please, bring with you:

- information materials (leaflets, photos, stickers, posters, etc.) about your organization or school to share with other participants. Please, bring also some digital presentations of your organisation (dvd, powerpoint presentation etc.)
- presentations about digital tools you use in your work with youth
- laptop to work on during the project meeting (one laptop for 2 people is ok)
- prepare some short energizers or games to play together
- food and drinks, national flag and anything else for presentation of your country during the Intercultural evenings.
- European Health Insurance Card, Private travel insurance proofs (on responsibility of each participant)
- personal toiletries and first aid (own specific medication)



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WHAT TO (OR NOT TO) EXPECT

- We will stay at a very nice and really comfortable place
- We will be in the mountains (about 600 m), so weather conditions can be a bit tricky
- Rooms are en-suite with central heating, bed-linen and towels are provided
- The nearest shop is 4 km down the hill and there is no public transport
- You can buy refreshments, drinks, snacks etc. in the restaurant bar
- Preparation activities and dissemination activities are a part of the project
- Venue and safety rules have to be followed by all participants
- You should attend 95% of the program to get reimbursement
- You should respect the program schedule in order to carry out successfully the activities
- Do not expect a one-week party of “project travellers”, this is definitely not our way of project work
